RESIDENTS MUST PARTICIPATE IN THE PAY-AS-YOU-THROW PROGRAM IN ORDER TO RECEIVE RECYCLING COLLECTION.

RECYCLING AND/OR TRASH MUST BE PLACED AT CURBSIDE BY 7 AM TO GUARANTEE COLLECTION. Daily route times are subject to change. Therefore, your recycling and/or trash might not be collected if they are not at curbside by 7 am, and the Town's Trash/Recycling hauler will be **UNDER NO OBLIGATION** to make a return trip to pick them up before your next scheduled collection day.

Disposal of Recyclable Items

PAPER PRODUCTS AS FOLLOWS: Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, catalogs, paperback books, phone books, white and colored paper, boxes from cereal, crackers, waxed cartons such as milk and orange juice boxes (with caps removed), mixes for bread, cakes, biscuits, corrugated cardboard, shoe boxes, envelopes and retail paper bags (with non-paper handles removed).

Glass bottles and jars of any color and any size. Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids, and aluminum foil. Please note food or drink containers must be rinsed and lids/caps removed, but labels may remain. **PLASTIC CONTAINERS ONLY** Labeled 1-7

Non-Recyclable Items

Plastic soda or beer holders, take-out trays, pizza boxes, egg cartons, hardback book covers, broken glass, window glass, Pyrex, paint cans, aerosol cans, metal items, plastic bags, containers over 2 gallons, motor oil or chemical containers, foam (Styrofoam) containers and flower pots. **ALL ACCEPTABLE, NON-RECYCLABLE ITEMS MUST BE DISPOSED OF IN A TOWN-DESIGNATED TRASH BAG OR BY AFFIXING A BULK ITEM LABEL.**

CARDBOARD is recyclable but must be cut up in 2 feet by 2 feet pieces. **Small pieces** of cardboard can be recycled with your paper. **Large pieces** of cardboard must be cut or folded, tied with string or twine and bundled no larger than 2 feet in any direction, weighing less than 40 lbs and placed next to the recycling bin. Please call the Engineering Department @ 508-393-5015 for information on disposal of large amounts of cardboard.

PIZZA BOXES and other contaminated cardboard food containers **ARE NOT RECYCLABLE**, must be disposed of in a Town trash bag and will not be considered a bulk item unless a **BULK ITEM LABEL** is affixed.

NOTES TO RESIDENTS

CENTRAL MASS DISPOSAL, INC., in Auburn, MA, will start collecting trash and recycling on July 1, 2011. They will also offer **SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING** to interested residents. Please contact them at 1-800-467-2801 or customerservice@cmdisposal.com for more details. Their website is: www.cmdisposal.com.

Trash/Recyclables must be out at curbside **BEFORE 7 AM**, otherwise they may not be taken.

Trash must be in TIED green Town PAYT bags or affixed with a BULK ITEM LABEL. (See "Large & Bulky Items" info below) **Loose** items in barrels will not be taken. **Overfilled, untied** Town bags in a barrel will not be taken.

Leaves, Grass Clippings and Hedge Trimmings may be brought to the DPW garage, 190 Main Street, Monday - Friday, 7:00 am - 2:00 pm.

All trash collected at curbside is taken to the Wheelabrator Millbury incineration facility for disposal.

Revenue from sales of PAYT Town bags and Bulk Item Labels pays for the trash & recycling curbside collection in Northborough.

DISPOSAL OF LARGE OR BULKY ITEMS

Two burnable large/bulky items, each with a **\$10 BULK ITEM LABEL** affixed, can be placed at the curb with your weekly trash. Items such as furniture, (fabric, wood or plastic), including Recliners and Loveseats with recliners, Gas Grills without tanks, Treadmills, Bicycles, Mattress or Box Springs, Wood or Carpeting, (rolled, tied in a bundle weighing less than 40 pounds, and not more than 4 feet wide), are acceptable as bulk items. Any bulk item that does not have a **\$10 BULK ITEM LABEL** affixed will not be taken. Items that are difficult to break up but would fit in a large town bag if broken up, may be put out at curbside in one piece with a **large** town bag attached (tied around it or taped to it. Example items: a shovel, mop, curtain rod, broom, etc.)

Any item that is on the **UNACCEPTABLE WASTE** list will not be taken, **EVEN IF A BULK ITEM LABEL IS ATTACHED.**

UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

Acids, Agricultural (Farm) Equipment, Air Conditioners, Ammunition, Animal Remains, Appliances, Asbestos, Asphalt Shingles, Bathtubs, Biological Wastes, Brush, Cable, Cathode Ray Tubes (CRT's), Caustics, Cesspool/Human Wastes, Chemicals, Cleaning Fluids, Computer Parts, Corrugated Cardboard, Crankcase Oils, Dishwashers, Oils (Drained), Dryers, Fiberglass Products, Firearms, Flammables, Freezers, Glass Containers, Grass Clippings, Hazardous Remains, Hedge Trimmings, Hot Water Heaters, Humidifiers, Insecticides, Large Machinery, Lawn Mowers, Lead Batteries, Leaves, Liquid Latex Paint, Liquid Waste, Logs, Marine Vessels, Mercury-containing Objects, Microwave Ovens, Motor Vehicles & Parts, Motorcycles & Parts, Narrow-Neck Plastic Containers, Oil Paint, Pathological Wastes, Pesticides, Petroleum Products, Poisons, Propane Tanks, Radioactive Materials, Recyclable Paper and Plastic, Refrigerators, Sheet Rock, Sinks, Sleep Sofas/Sofa Beds, Snowmobiles & Parts, Stoves, Televisions, Thermometers (Mercury), Thermostats, Tires, Toilets, Trailers, Tree Stumps, Video Screens, Wall Board, Washing Machines, Wire and Wood (over 1'x4')

Please Note: Northborough residents performing minor construction projects on their own property are eligible to set out 2 bundles (per week) of construction debris, **WITH A BULK ITEM LABEL AFFIXED TO EACH BUNDLE**, in the appropriate size, (maximum of 4 feet in length and 1 foot in diameter with a bundled weight of less than forty pounds), with their solid waste, **provided it is BURNABLE, ACCEPTABLE WASTE. Any construction or demolition performed by a private contractor requires a dumpster.**

DISPOSAL OF UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

APPLIANCES When purchasing a new appliance, arrange for disposal of your old one by the retailer.

PROPANE TANKS Rocky's Ace Hardware, 261 West Main Street, 508-393-5428, charges \$5 to take empty tanks. Trade-in program available at Rocky's Ace Hardware and WalMart, 200 Otis Street, 508-393-4385.

LEAD ACID BATTERIES Northeast Battery: 508-832-2700 & Interstate Battery: 508-791-7904

NON-RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES Put in the regular trash (A, AA, AAA, C, D, etc.)

MERCURY Drop-off at Town Hall includes button cell and rechargeable batteries, thermometers and thermostats.

FLUORESCENT LIGHT BULBS - Drop off at Rocky's Ace Hardware (up to 4-feet in length)

OIL-BASED PAINT Watch for Household Hazardous Waste Day in the Fall. (Cans of dried Latex paint can be put in the regular trash).
