

# **ATTENTION KINDERGARTEN PARENTS**

Are you in need of before and/or after school care for your child now that they are entering the public school system? The Northborough Extended Day Program (NEDP) offers a quality child care service within your child's school for children in grades K -5.

## **THE NEDP PROGRAM:**

- is located in the cafeteria of each of the four elementary schools
- is licensed by the Massachusetts Department of Early Education and Care (EEC)
- has been in operation since 1987
- is open for Before School Care from 7:00 a.m. until school begins (presently at Lincoln Street and Peaslee Schools) \*NOTE: will open Zeh and Proctor Schools when enrollment permits
- is open for Extended Day Care from school dismissal until 6:00 p.m.
- follows the public school calendar and is closed for holidays, snow days, professional days, etc.
- is open on days school is in session including early release days for parent-teacher conferences
- offers February and April vacation weeks

## **IN ADDITION:**

- Our staff members are mature, highly trained and chosen for their experience, creativity and sensitivity to the needs of the children.
- Our staff are present to attend to individual needs, lead activities and facilitate each child's physical, emotional and social growth.
- The various organized teacher led as well as child initiated activities meet the needs for recreation, cultural enrichment, cooperative play and social learning.

Application forms will be dated and timed as they are received.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

**Tuition payments are due the first of the month from August 2018 through May 2019**

- ❖ There is a \$40.00 non-refundable registration fee for Before and/or After School per application.
- ❖ There is a \$20.00 non-refundable registration fee for **Before School ONLY** per application.
- ❖ There is an option for drop in care **Before School ONLY** - \$10.00/Day (your child **must be registered prior to first drop in**).
- ❖ There are two options available for the February & April vacation weeks:
  1. Four days (T,W,Th, F) - \$260.00 (There is a 10% discount for each additional sibling).
  2. Two days (parents circle the days child will attend - T,W,Th, F ) - \$130.00 (There is a 10% discount for each additional sibling).
- ❖ There is a \$25.00 fee per day for the three half days for parent/teacher conferences.
- ❖ There is \$25.00 fee per day for an extra day request.

*Financial aid may be available to families who complete a financial aid application, provide all documentation required and qualify within the guidelines of the Department of Early Education and Care Parent Co-Payment Table.*
