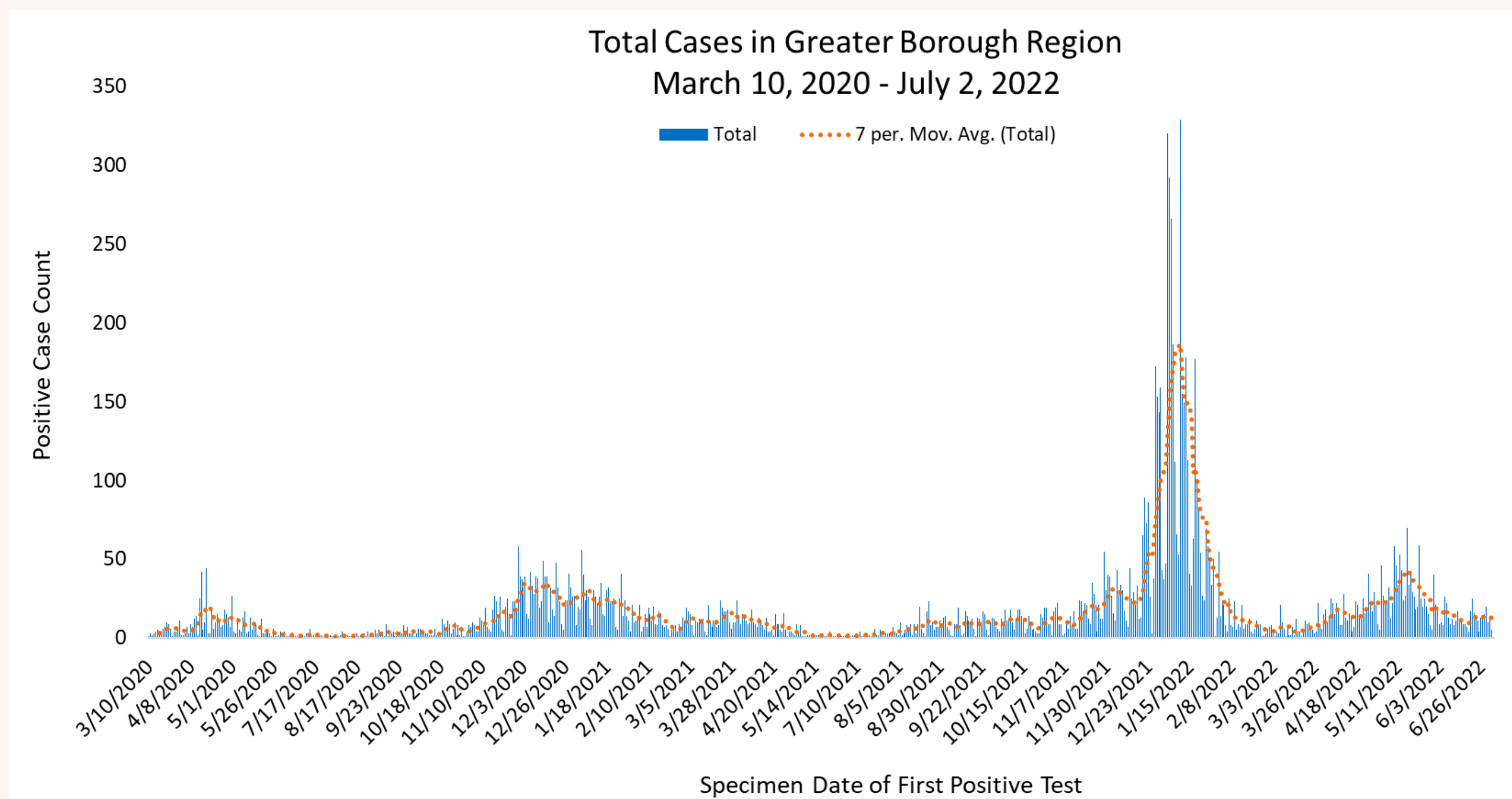


Wastewater data from Biobot Analytics shows an **increase** in SARS-CoV-2 virus.
