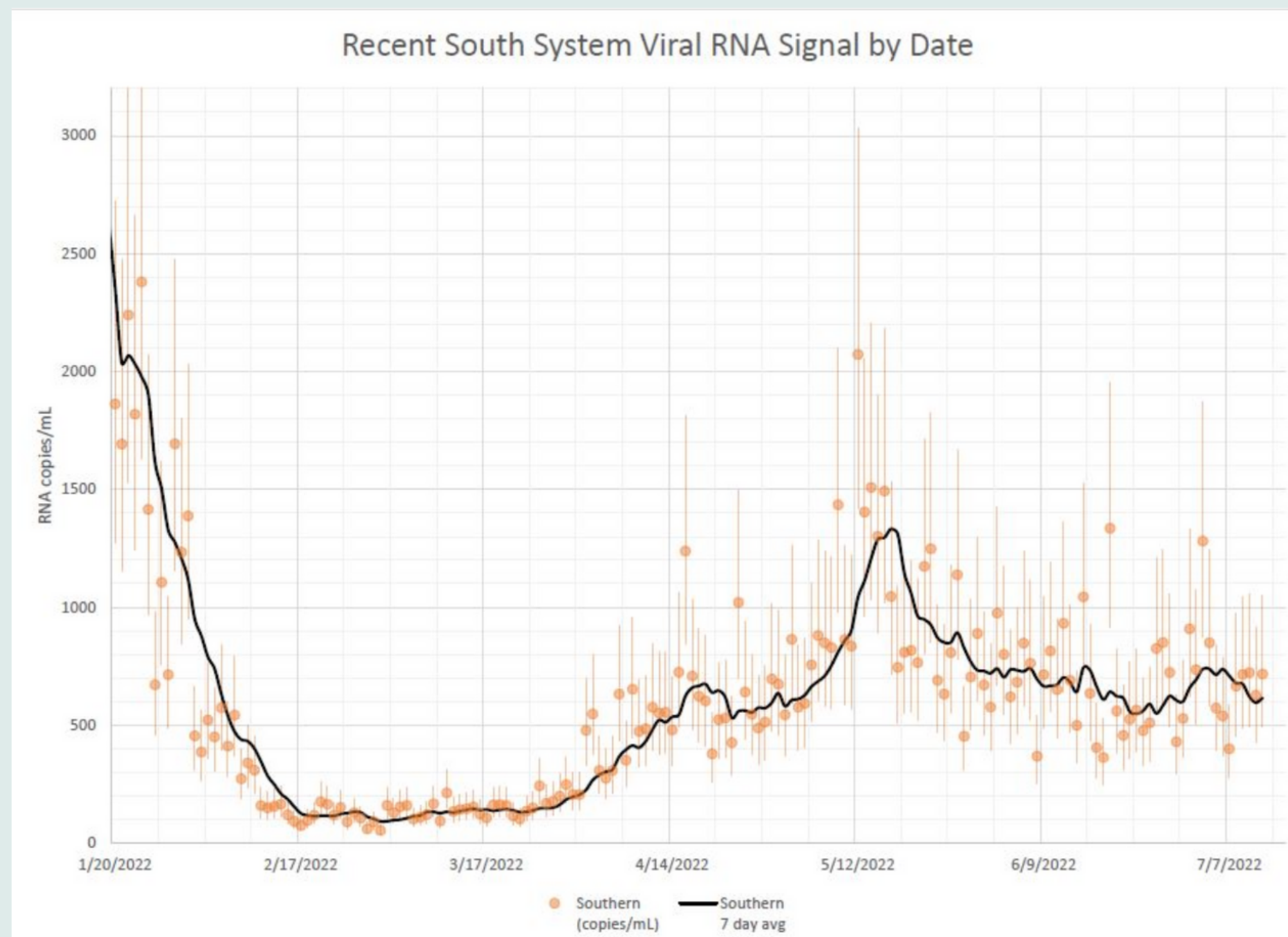
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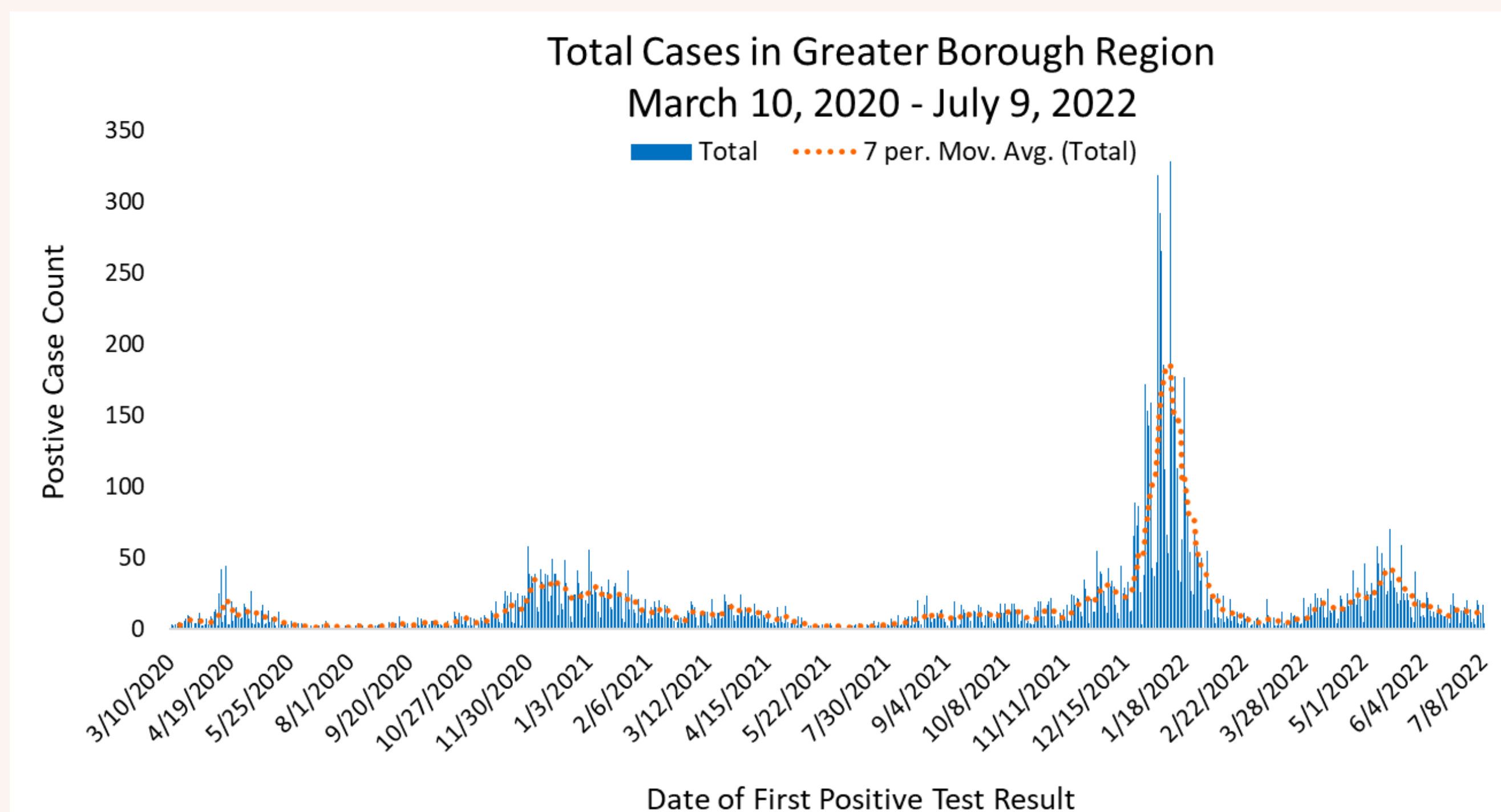
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Wastewater data from the South System of MWRA shows a slight increase in SARS-CoV-2 virus.
