


Question 5: As a town resident, what do you think defines Northborough? Think of fauna, flora, landscape, architecture, history, people, events or anything else that gives our town a unique character.

•	Apples, apple farms, apple orchards, farms	16


Question 6: Prior to this survey were you aware that artists, community groups, and schools' organizations may apply for grants from the Northborough Cultural Council?



Question 7: To help us understand our programing audience, please select your age range.


