

# COVID-19 Vaccines for Kids Under Five

## What to know

- On June 18th, the CDC approved COVID-19 vaccines for children ages 6 months to 5 years old.
- The COVID-19 vaccine has been shown to be safe, effective, and protective against serious illness.
- Vaccines are FREE for everyone.

Two vaccines are available for children and both are proven to be effective:

- Pfizer is a 3-dose series. The first two doses are administered 3 weeks apart, and the third dose is administered 8 weeks after the second dose.
- Moderna is a 2-dose series. The two doses are administered 1 month apart.

Please contact your child's pediatrician with any questions about the vaccines.

## Where can my child get vaccinated?

**Talk to your pediatrician about whether their office is offering the vaccine.**

- Some pediatric providers are scheduling clinics and will send out emails once appointments are available. Call or use your patient portal to schedule.
