Mrs. Frank, Senior member of the Regional School Committee, opened the Regional School Committee Open Meeting at 7:05 p.m.

# **ELECTION OF OFFICERS**

Mrs. Frank explained the practice of alternating Southborough and Northborough committee members as officers. Last year's election was Northborough members and tonight's election would be Southborough members.

# Chairperson

Mrs. Frank asked for nominations for Chairperson.

Mr. Desmond nominated Ms. Cathy Kea as Chairperson of the Regional School Committee (only nomination brought forth), Mr. Butka seconded, and it was unanimously voted, "To elect Ms. Cathy Kea as the Chairperson of the Regional School Committee."

MOTION ON CHAIRPERSON

Ms. Kea accepted the nomination and position as the Chairperson.

# Vice-Chairperson

Ms. Kea requested nominations for Vice-Chairperson of the Regional School Committee.

Mr. Desmond nominated Ms. Kathleen Polutchko for Vice-Chairperson of the Regional School Committee, Mr. Butka seconded, and it was unanimously voted, "To elect Ms. Kathleen Polutchko as Vice-Chairperson of the Regional School Committee."

Ms. Polutchko agreed to accept the nomination and position as Vice-Chairperson.

#### Secretary

Ms. Kea requested nominations for Secretary of the Regional School Committee.

Ms. Polutchko nominated Mr. Paul Desmond (only nomination brought forth), Mr. Desmond seconded, and it was unanimously voted, "To elect Mr. Paul Desmond as Secretary of the Regional School Committee."

# SCHOOL CHOICE PUBLIC HEARING

Ms. Kea opened the Public Hearing at 7:07 p.m. Superintendent Johnson provided an overview of school choice. Superintendent Johnson did not recommend that our district participate in school choice for this coming year. She recommended that the school committee review the program next year. She shared components influencing the decision such as fluctuations in student enrollments, requirement to accept siblings of school choice students, course selection process, classroom sizes, and per pupil expense (\$17,040 at Algonquin, \$5K for school choice reimbursement per pupil). Superintendent Johnson explained the need for the Regional School Committee to take a vote and inform the Department of Elementary and Secondary (DESE) by June 1, 2019 otherwise, the District would automatically be considered a school choice district.

Committee members and Superintendent Johnson discussed the international program and costs. We had one student enroll in the 2018-2019 school year. Committee members discussed the benefits of the program for the future.

Ms. Kea asked for audience participation; no one responded. Ms. Kea closed the Public Hearing at 7:20 p.m.

### C. NEW BUSINESS:

1. School Choice Vote – Ms. Kea asked for discussion and action.

Mr. Butka motioned, Mr. Kolenda seconded, and it was unanimously voted, "The Northborough-Southborough Regional School Committee votes to not participate in School Choice in FY2020 and to direct our Superintendent to notify the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education of this decision no later than June 1, 2019."

2. Social Studies Department Presentation – Ms. Brittany Burns, Department Chairperson, presented a PowerPoint highlighting staff and students and shared a comprehensive overview of course offerings. She thanked her 15 member department and gave special recognition for Ms. Christina Smith for finishing her doctorate program.

Topics discussed included: the new social studies standards, the K-12 alignment of social studies and working closely with K-12 curriculum leaders, professional

development, NEF Grant, department highlights, goals, collaboration, global issues, speakers, and community. Ms. Burns introduced two graduating seniors who spoke about their experiences at Algonquin and future plans in college.

Committee members thanked Ms. Burns for the time this evening and asked the students for feedback on how the School Committee could help more.

3. 2019-2020 School Committee Subcommittee and Liaison Assignments – Superintendent Johnson reviewed and recommended that members inform the Chair of their interest.

#### D. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE:

1. Principal's Report – Mr. Andrew McGowan, Assistant Principal, gave an update on activities and events at Algonquin including: Tiny Tomahawks event, Annual Town Cleanup, DECA competition, Senior Ball, Junior Prom this coming Saturday, Algonquin Writing Center, Athletics, upcoming MCAS, Algonquin Games, Applied Arts and Technology video, Big Group 9<sup>th</sup> grade team, Library efforts, *Harbinger*, Physical education, and appreciation efforts.

Committee members thanked Mr. McGowan for the update this evening.

Mr. Butka motioned, Mr. Kolenda seconded, and it was unanimously voted, "To re-appoint Mrs. Lynne Winter as Assistant Treasurer for the upcoming year."

# E. <u>OLD BUSINESS</u>:

- 1. Athletics Update
  - Guide to Athletics Mr. Mike Mocerino gave an update on Athletics and accomplishments this evening. He expressed gratitude to our Booster's Club for involvement in our athletics, banquets, funding, and support. June 18<sup>th</sup> is the golf fundraiser for the Booster's Club.

Mr. Mocerino reviewed the 2019-2020 changes to Algonquin Guide to Athletics. He thanked all the parents, students, and athletes for the efforts in updating the Guide to Athletics. Mr. Butka requested more information on Impact Testing to be included in the final version.

2. Student Handbook Approval – Ms. Tontodonato gave an update on the handbook efforts of many.

Mr. Kolenda motioned, Mr. Butka seconded, and it was unanimously voted, "To approve the Student Handbook at presented."

Ms. Polutchko read comments about Superintendent Johnson's skills, character, collaboration, and professionalism. She stated that the most often used descriptions are collaborative, commitment, and leadership skills. Superintendent Johnson thanked the Committee and extended her appreciation for the District's support of our schools.
