Mrs. Winter called the Northborough-Southborough Regional School Committee Open Meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

### A. ACTION ON MINUTES:

1. Action on the Minutes of the Open Meeting of March 20, 2019. Mrs. Winter asked for discussion and action on the minutes.

Mr. Butka motioned, Mr. Kolenda seconded and it was unanimously voted, "To approve the minutes MINUTES" the Open Meeting of March 20, 2019"

#### B. EDUCATIONAL POLICY:

1. Approval of Overnight Fieldtrip to U.S. Presidential Inauguration January 18-21, 2021 in Washington D.C.

Mr. Butka motioned, Mr. Kolenda seconded and it was voted 7-1-0, Mr. O'Shea opposed, "To Approve the Overnight Fieldtrip to the U.S. Presidential Inauguration January 18-21, 2021."

#### C. NEW BUSINESS:

- Math Department Presentation Ms. Beth Dore, Math Teacher, reviewed the members of the math department, the course offerings, curriculum and initiatives: current and future, MCAS 2.0, and the computer science course offerings. Ms. Dore introduced Anthony Zalev, Algonquin High School Senior and President of the Programming Club, to demonstrate the app he created. Anthony answered questions from the School Committee Members who said they were very impressed with his work and presentation. Ms. Dore answered questions from the School Committee Members.
- MCAS Update Assistant Principal McDonald gave an overview of the planning, training, and implementation of the MCAS 2.0 online testing. He thanked Assistant Superintendent Greg Martineau, Principal Pragluski Walsh, and staff for the hard work and support that went into making the testing successful.

3. Recap of Town Meetings – Superintendent Johnson said the Northborough Budget, Regional School Budget, and warrant articles passed. She mentioned two Citizen Petition Articles presented by Algonquin student, Shariva Tanikella. Superintendent Johnson praised Shariva for her presentation and the work done by the Green Earth Club.

# D. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE:

1. Principal Update – Principal Pragluski Walsh gave an update on academics, clubs and activities, and events at Algonquin including: the MAJE Competitions, National English Honor Society, Money Talks initiative with Mr. John Coderre, Northborough Town Manager, the Fitchburg State University Programming Competition, Student Council Blood Drive and Food Drive, Framingham State All Star Competition, The Harbinger, Algonquin sports game day openers, Cheerleading, Unified Track, Physics, Robotics, Fine Arts, Applied Arts, and Guidance. She mentioned the Jr. Prom will be held on Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup> at Union Station and the Boosters will hold their golf tournament on June 18, 2019. She thanked Assistant Principal McDonald, Assistant Superintendent Martineau, Mr. Thomas (TJ) Carron, Mr. Brian Calnan, Ms. Susan Whalen and the District Instructional Technology Team for all their efforts to make the MCAS 2.0 online testing successful.

The School Committee Member's asked questions, made comments, and thanked Principal Pragluski Walsh.

- 2. Enrollments Superintendent Johnson said current and projected enrollments are included in the packet. She discussed potential funding shifts which provided for funding increases in previous reductions of .4 FTE in Fine & Applied Arts and the funding of a .5 FTE in Health & Fitness, and administrative reductions.
- 3. FY'19 Monthly General Fund Expenditure Report as of March 31, 2019 Included in the packet. Superintendent Johnson said she is very pleased with where we are in the Operational Budget at this time and requested a vote to approve until audited.

Mr. Butka motioned, Mr. Kolenda seconded and it was voted unanimously "To approve the FY'19 Statement of Revenue dated March 31, 2019 and the FY'19 Monthly General Fund Expenditure Report as of March 31, 2019 until audited."
