

Town of Northborough Conservation Commission Notice of Public Hearings

There will be a meeting of the Northborough Conservation Commission on Monday, January 8, 2024, at 6:00 pm.

Pursuant to Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2023, An Act Relative to Extending Certain COVID-19 Measures Adopted During the State of Emergency, signed into law on March 29, 2023, this meeting will be conducted via remote participation. No in-person attendance by members or the public will be permitted. The meeting will include the following hearings pursuant to MGL Chapter 131, Section 40, the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, the Northborough Wetlands Protection Bylaw, and/or the Northborough Stormwater Management and Land Disturbance Bylaw:

Application for a Notice of Intent at 10 Blueberry Lane (Map 47, Parcel 85) owned by Winston Soboyejo, to replace a failed septic system within the 100' wetland buffer zone.

Application for a Request for Determination of Applicability at 14 Mohawk Drive (Map 37, Parcel 7) owned by William McCarthy to add fill to replace a failed septic system in the outer 100' buffer zone.

Application for a Notice of Intent at 6 Hillside Road (Map 105, Parcel 18) owned by Enis Shehu of Whiteacre Properties, to renovate the existing structure and deck within the same footprint, install an overhang, and replace a failed septic system. Work is proposed within the 25' No Disturb Zone, and throughout the 100' wetland buffer zone.
