The meeting will include the following hearings pursuant to MGL Chapter 131, Section 40, the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, the Northborough Wetlands Protection Bylaw, and/or the Northborough Stormwater Management and Land Disturbance Bylaw:

Notice of Intent: Bartlett Pond (Maps/Parcels 65/99 & 66/1) owned by the Town of Northborough to control the growth of non-native aquatic plants in Bartlett Pond from 2024-2026 using US EPA certified methods and herbicides. The work will occur on the pond with access via Watson Park boat ramp.

Notice of Intent: 289 Lyman Street (Map 86, Parcel 2) for work requested by the Town of Westborough on land owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance (DCAMM) to construct a stormwater drainage discharge system. The work will occur within the 25' No Disturb buffer, and the 100' Wetland Buffer Zone.
