November 2022 Minutes were approved. There was no formal December 2022 meeting.

Topics Covered:

- 1) Trail Maintenance Updates
 - a. Cold Harbor trail: bridge closest to Church St. needs to be repaired. Lumber will be needed. Floating bridge is also in need of repair. In the spring/summer we'll need to see what action can be taken in the Cherry Street meadow with the long trail bridge and the section of the path after the trail bridge that is always muddy.
 - b. Yellick Trail is clear; including Bill's work on the Tall Grass trail
 - c. Stirrup Brook trail is clear
 - d. Coyote trail near Assabet River is in need of another bench-cutting effort in some sections
 - e. Mt. Pisgah, there are trees down across the trails in the MassWildlife section. We have left these trees down due to the "No Maintenance" policy of MassWildlife and it appears as if people are just walking around the fallen trees making a new trail.
- 2) Equipment
 - a. Need a new license plate for the equipment trailer since the previous one was stolen.
 - b. Should we try to see the old Bachtold brush mower? It's not getting used and the shed is full.
- 3) Future: Scout troop 823 may be available to assist on some projects
