- MATEC has outgrown the space, can't get industrial vehicles into the area
- Owner looked at moving the business, but it's not feasible
- New footprint would be approximately the same
- Public comment:
 - Dr. Ruediger Volk asked how much the cost would be to build with brick, and whether the town could chip in to help with that.
 - o Tom responded that design is already through Design Review Committee and ZBA, did not consider brick due to cost, what is in the plan should be OK visually
- Millie moved that the demolition delay be waived, Mike seconded, all in favor

 - Norm emailed and sent additional info, hoping to have something to review by Feb meeting
- Historic Preservation Plan
 - No report
- Archeological Sites in Northborough
 - Received package with maps of all archaeological site in Northborough from Mass Historical Comm on December 22

- They highly recommend that the town hire someone to perform site surveys
- There are 20 ancient sites and 3 historical sites (sites where structures no longer exist). Each site has a report
- Mike will send the package to Kathy Joubert to maintain
- Could CPA funding be used for surveys?
- Many of the reports reference artifacts displayed in the Northborough Historical Society
- Mike will ask other towns how they addressed such surveys
- Old Grange Hall, 10 School Street
 - There is a party interested in buying, wants to make it a single-family home
- > Planned Demolitions on old State Hospital grounds
 - Norm contacted Mass Hist Comm, who told him to contact DCAMM
 - Will ask: What will they demolish? Will they want to demolish Chauncy Hall?
 - Norm will also ask for permission to take pictures
- NHDC representation on other committees
 - White Cliffs Committee
 - The contractor completed the contract. There is a link to Town's website with thorough evaluation
 - Community Preservation Committee
 - Application for Historical Society was approved (\$22K)
 - Payment for White Cliffs bond was approved
 - Master Plan Implementation Committee
 - All members selected
